How do you personalise makeup for each bride?

I like to be involved in the entire process well in advance, from selecting the outfit and jewellery to choosing accessories, drapes, and addressing skin concerns. This ensures that on the final day, there are no surprises for either of us.

What should a bride keep in mind when choosing a makeup artist?

For a makeup artist, dressing up brides is a daily routine, but for the bride, it's the most important day of her life. A bride should choose an artist whose priority is her comfort and focus, rather than one who is more concerned with creating content at her expense.

Which bridal makeup trend do you currently love? Nude lip shades are always in demand and are truly timeless.

What's your go-to technique for bridal makeup?

I use the reverse contouring technique, where contouring is done before applying foundation. This brings out chiselled features without creating a brown muddy shadow, making the makeup look more radiant.

How do you personalise makeup for every bride? I always start by understanding the bride's vision, whether she's imagining bold red lips or a subtle nude shade. Then, I suggest ways to enhance her natural beauty while aligning with her desires.

What should a bride keep in mind when choosing a makeup artist?

It's important to review the makeup artist's social media profiles, especially videos that show their techniques and how they interact with brides. This gives insight into what to expect.

Which bridal makeup trend do you currently love?

I'm loving the resurgence of the classic red bride—bold red lips with traditional red lehengas. It's a timeless look.

What's your go-to technique for bridal makeup?

I always save the lashes for last to avoid any mess or glitter fallout. I also apply lipstick just before the bride leaves, ensuring her lips stay flawless and perfectly intact for the big moment. •







FABRIC AND TEXTURE PLAY:


While silk, brocade, and jacquard are the go-to fabrics for grooms, men are now experimenting with textures.
Think linen, for a summer wedding, or rich velvet for a winter nuptial.



REVRING THE RULES

A glimpse into the evolving landscape of Indian weddings.



lanning a wedding is like opening a Pandora's box full of surprises, with a list of never-ending chores that can feel overwhelming. Whether you're spending a year or just three months planning your nuptials, it never seems enough. However, while the basic wedding checklist remains true, it's essential to recognise the evolution of these festivities. The most notable

trend for 2024 is the shift toward intimate weddings. "Couples are now more thoughtful about spending, focusing on meaningful experiences rather than just grandeur. There is also a growing emphasis on ensuring guests have a good time, moving beyond traditional formats," shared Devanshi Patel, Founder of Shreem Events. This shift can largely be attributed to millennials, who are at the forefront of driving change. As they move away from traditional arranged marriages, often meeting their partners through dating apps, the nature of weddings is changing.

PERSONALISATION: Personal touches have become

crucial in making weddings memorable. Couples are now crafting their own vows, designing bespoke gifts, and including personal notes or letters. The trend of exchanging personalised vows borrowed from Western customs—is gaining momentum. This heartfelt practice, whether during the engagement or before the varmala ceremony, adds a unique and personal touch to the celebration.

DIY AND FOOD STATIONS:

Interactive elements, such as DIY stations, are emerging as a significant trend, encouraging guests to engage more actively. This shift highlights a growing focus on making the wedding experience enjoyable for everyone, not just the couple and their families, according to Patel. Instead of single signature cocktails, couples are now curating elaborate DIY drink stations—table-side martinis, roaming gin carts with exotic ingredients, and full tequila bars paired with gourmet desserts or grazing tables.

The culinary landscape is also evolving, with a blend of gourmet dishes

and comfort foods gaining popularity. "For instance. stations featuring masala khichdi or chhole-bhaturerajma-chawal have become popular and often stand out on the wedding menu," Patel notes.

THE POWER OF WHITE: White, traditionally associated with mourning, is now gaining popularity as a choice for bridal wear. Ivory lehengas and sherwanis are becoming preferred options for modern brides and grooms due to their timeless appeal.


JEWELLED LEGACY: Brides are also moving away from extravagant, single-use outfits, favouring attire that can be worn again. The approach to jewellery is similarly evolving, with many brides prioritising financial practicality and sustainability over traditional emotional attachments. Renting jewellery or opting for artificial pieces is becoming more common.

NEW DESTINATIONS: One of the most promising segments of the wedding industry is wedding tourism,

especially experiential destinations as wedding venues. The percentage of destination weddings has increased to 21% in 2024, compared to 18% in 2022. Earlier, all big, fat weddings were hosted in Rajasthan or Goa but now places like Rishikesh have become popular. Parthip Thyagarajan, Co-Founder & CEO of Wedding Sutra, highlights this trend, "Destinations like Orchha in Madhya Pradesh, and Rishikesh and Dehradun in Uttarakhand, are gaining popularity. Amritsar in Punjab and Mahabalipuram in Tamil Nadu continue to attract destination weddings, while Jamnagar in the West has been spotlighted thanks to the Ambani celebrations." Additionally, Patel highlights that "destinations like Kashmir, Sri Lanka, Ras Al Khaimah in the UAE, and even Italy and France are becoming top choices for weddings." Overall, Indian

weddings are evolving with a focus on personalisation, unique experiences, and distinctive destinations, reflecting a shift towards more meaningful and customised celebrations. •
