MODERN MAHARAJAS AND MAHARANIS

Indian Couture is getting more modern and refreshing day after day. What started as wearing jackets with saris, soon evolved into jackets with lehengas, corset saris, and creative plays on drapes. For the younger generation, it is all about fusing heritage with ease. Peplums are making a stylish comeback for women, while men, too, are embracing a more experimental, fashion-forward approach.



reworking fabrics into fuss-free ensembles made for dancing the night away, while stylists are adding flavour and flair. From saris with corsets or bikini blouses to lighter pants with men's kurtas, modern silhouettes keep heritage alive with comfort.

-IN VOGUE





From double dupattas to sleek Scandinavian scarves, retro-inspired patterns, dhoti pants, and pleated kurtas for men—drapes are being reimagined in the most exciting ways this season.

This festive season, fashion is all about reinventing the classics—especially drapes. For centuries, draping has been an integral part of Indian culture, from dhotis and lungis to saris. Their beauty lies in their ability to let you move with ease while still looking stylish.

WOMEN: Over the years, the traditional drape has seen endless reinterpretations, and this year, it is all about sculpted structures and fluid layers. Designer Gazal Gupta highlights the sculpted sari drape, defined by sharp pleats and pre-stitched pallus that create an architectural silhouette, perfect for cocktail evenings. Equally chic is the cape-and-sari fusion, where sheer or embroidered capes replace the pallu, adding drama without fuss. For brides, the double dupatta lehenga drape continues to reign supreme, now refreshed with scalloped trims, organza layers, or contrasting colours. The belted drape is another favourite; it cinches the waist, adds ease of movement, making it perfect for sangeets and mehndis. For a touch of Western bridal flair, shoulder veils with trails make Indian ensembles feel ethereal, ideal for receptions or *phera*s.

Gupta believes that blouses also play a pivotal role in elevating these drapes. Think corset blouses with sweetheart necklines for sculpted saris, high-neck embroidered styles to pair with shoulder veils, and cape-sleeve blouses that make monotone saris look grand. For lehengas with double dupattas, plunging necklines strike the perfect balance, while boat necks with embellished sleeves keep belted styles timeless. And for those who like to experiment, TikTok's viral Scandinavian scarf drape has become a trend to watch.

MEN: In men's fashion, drapes are no longer an afterthought, they are quickly becoming a defining style statement. Designers are revisiting the dhoti, with versions ranging from sharply tailored to fluid, couture-inspired interpretations. "Draping in menswear has evolved into a strong design statement," shares Gupta. "Asymmetrical drapes, pre-stitched *angarakha*s, layered shawl drapes, and draped bandhgalas are incredibly popular right now." These styles mix fluidity with a masculine edge, making them versatile for weddings and formal gatherings.

Beyond the dhoti, festive wardrobes are seeing innovations in tapered cowl pants, stylized salwars, and wide-leg trousers paired with draped kurtas or bandhgalas. Asymmetrical hemlines, layered pleats, and Angrakha-style crossovers add texture and movement, while structured bandhgalas are being paired with draped stoles, creating a seamless blend of tradition and modernity.

Modern Minimalist Bride: A silk saree with a clean, pre-draped pallu over a structured corset blouse. Minimal jewellery, bold makeup. **The Regal Bride**: Double dupatta lehenga, one tissue dupatta over the head, one organza with fine zari work draped Gujarati-style across the front.

The Boho Bride: An asymmetric sari drape worn over flared pants or a skirt paired with a fringed blouse or jacket.

DRAPES FOR GROOMS

TASVA

For men, layer a fluidly draped stole over a structured sherwani either over one shoulder or wrapped across the torso like a modern-day warrior. Another option is a draped *angarakha* with tonal embroidery, paired with tailored trousers or a dhoti.

For festive occasions, I suggest playing with textures and layering, maybe a cowl neck kurta with a brocade *bandi* or a pre-draped kurta styled with a printed stole. It is about balance, letting one element be the hero while keeping the rest minimal.


